The PGY2 Internal Medicine Pharmacy Residency is a 12-month program that provides robust clinical training in a variety of clinical settings. Pharmacy provides clinical coverage for all the medical, surgical, intensive care, spinal cord injury, and mental health teams covering every inpatient veteran using the Comprehensive Care Model that is a team-based and patient-centered integrated practice model where we provide comprehensive medication management. The program will be individualized based on the residents previous experience and/or interests.

The Rocky Mountain Regional VA Medical Center is a Complexity Level 1a facility, treating the highest acuity of patients by having the largest breadth of physician specialties that focus on teaching and research and who provide a full-range of state-of-the-art patient care services at our newly built (2018) facility. RMR is a 182-bed teaching hospital with a 30-bed spinal-cord injury treatment center. Internal medicine pharmacists practice at the peak of their license at this facility.
