

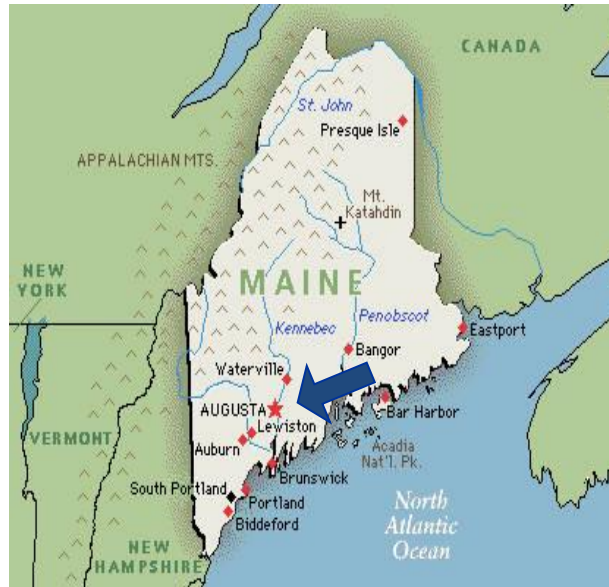
About Augusta
