HOW TO APPLY

Qualifications

- Doctor of Pharmacy or equivalent
- Licensure/eligibility in the U.S. (any state)
- U.S. Citizen

Application Process

- Letter of Intent (describing interest in specific program)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Pharmacy academic transcript
- Three references completed through the PhORCAS standardized reference form. Writers should comment on as many of the characteristics as possible, but at minimum these below:
 - Oral communication skills
 - Ability to organize and manage time
 - Ability to work with peers and communicate
 - Clinical problem solving skills
 - Independence and resourcefulness
 - Willingness to accept constructive criticism
 - Effective patient interaction
- Virtual interviews will be offered for selected candidates after review of application materials no later than February 12, 2025.

Purpose

PGY1 residency programs build upon Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and outcomes to develop pharmacist practitioners with knowledge, skills, and abilities as defined in the educational competency areas, goals, and objectives. Residents who successfully complete PGY1 residency programs will be skilled in diverse patient care, practice management, leadership, and education, and be prepared to provide patient care, seek board certification in pharmacotherapy (i.e., BCPS), and pursue advanced education and training opportunities including postgraduate year two (PGY2) residencies.

The Salisbury VA Health Care System Residency Program participates in the ASHP Pharmacy Residency matching Program. This residency site agrees that no person at the site will solicit, accept, or use any ranking-related information from any residency applicant. Appointment is contingent upon satisfactory completion of requirements for federal employment.
