

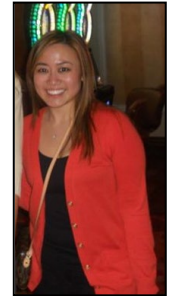


# VA HVHCS Past PGY2 Ambulatory Care Pharmacy Residents Where Are They Now?

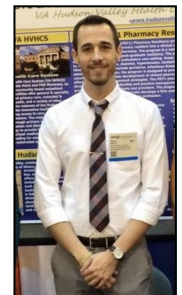


## 2014-2015: Angela Olenik, PharmD, BCPS

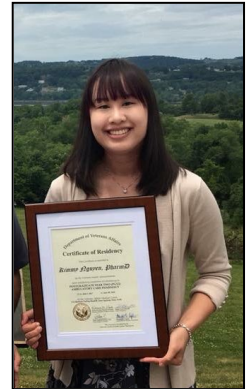
## 2016-2017: Taryn Mondiello, PharmD, BCACP
